Traditional watercolor techniques will be emphasized in this 8-session class. We will experiment with wash, wet on wet, drybrush techniques. The student will learn to combine watercolor with drawing media and other materials. Working from direct observation of still life, landscape photographs and one's imagination. Students are encouraged to experiment and develop their own styles. Students will gain a solid foundation of watercolor skills that can be used in illustration, notational drawing or fine art expression.
